The aim of the group coaching is for the participants to reflect on themselves and their working environment in a "safe space" and to develop a persor networking strategy. This is based on the idea of the comfort zone model: Staying in your individual comfort zone with one foot, I leaving it with the other. This is exactly where the workshop comes in and serves to empower participants to become more self-
